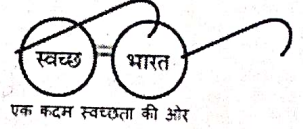

WALK IN INTERVIEW

It is proposed to fill up the vacant posts of Senior Resident & Junior Resident in Rajan Babu Institute of Pulmonary Medicine & Tuberculosis, Municipal Corporation Delhi, for Regular basis. A walk - in interview will be conducted on 06/02/2025 for SRs & JRs Registration for the same will be between 09.30 am to 1 pm on 06/02/2025 at RBIPMT- Director Office.

All eligible candidates desirous of attending the interview must report to PA to Director, RBIPMT with original and attested copies of Date of Birth proof, mark sheets of professional examination, internship completion certificate, MBBS degree, valid DMC registration, experience certificate if any, and SC/ST/OBC certificate if claimed. OBC certificate will be considered only if issued from Govt. of India. One Passport size photograph is also to be submitted. Candidates who have done graduation from foreign universities must also submit their score of FMIGE/ National Board of Examination screening examination.

Requisite qualification of Sr. Resident:

- MBBS Degree from MCI/NMC Recognized University/Institution.
- PG degree/DNB/Diploma, or equivalent in concerned Specialty from a recognized institution.
- If adequate candidates as per (b) above are not available in particular specialty, then candidates with MBBS Degree with two years of experience, cut of which one year should be in concerned specialty, can be considered.

Requisite qualification of Jr. Resident:

- MBBS Degree from MCI/NMC Recognized University/Institution.
- Must have Completed One Rotatory Internship before date of Joining.
- The internship should have been completed not earlier than two years before last date of application.

Duration of Sr. Residency:

Engagement will be for period of one year initially, extendable by one year at a time up to total of three year. Extension is subject to satisfactory work and conduct report.

Duration of Jr. Residency:

The JR will be appointed for a period of 6 month, extendable further for six months (total of one year) Extension is subject to satisfactory work and conduct report

Tenure:

- Total tenure of Senior Residency will not normally exceed three years Including the period served in other Govt. Hospitals.
- In case enough candidates are not available as per (a) above, then the candidates who have completed 3 years of senior residency but are willing to serve as Senior Residents will be allowed to appear in the Interview. A separate list of such candidates will be prepared and this list will be considered after list of fresh candidate as per (a) above is exhausted. However total tenure of Senior Residency will not exceed five years including the period served in other Govt. Hospitals.

(It is clarified that aforesaid provision (b) made in relaxation of the provisions of the Residency Scheme are only enabling provisions. In the first place the recruitments have to be made strictly as per the Residency Scheme as circulated by the Ministry of Health & Family welfare: vide GOI OM No. 11014/03/91-ME (P) dated 05-6-1992).

Age Limit for SR:

Not exceeding 45 years as on last day of submission of application. (Relaxable by five years in case of ST/SC candidates, by three years in case of OBC candidates and by Ten years in case of PwD candidates).


Age Limit JRS:

Not exceeding 40 years as on last day of submission of application. (Relaxable by five years in case of ST/SC candidates, by three years in case of OBC candidates and by Ten years in case of PwD candidates).

Terms & Condition for appointment of SR & JR:

- i) All appointments will be subject to medical fitness and verification of certificates of educational qualification/ caste/age/DMC registration and internship completion certificate
- ii) For candidate applying for OBC category, the certificate must be issued by competent authority of Govt. of India
- iii) The service will be governed under Residency Scheme (Ref. No. S 11014/3/91ME(P) Govt of India, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare dated 05.06.1992 (290-420) and amendment thereafter/relaxation as detailed in eligibility criteria.
- iv) No TA/DA will be paid for appearing for Interview
- v) No private practice whatsoever will be allowed during residency
- vi) The service can be terminated at any time without assigning any reason.
- vii) Other service conditions will be applicable as per service conditions prescribed from time to time by Govt. of India
- viii) Inter hospital/inter institutional transfer shall not be permitted.
- ix) The Appointing Authority reserves right to assign any duty as and when required. No extra allowance will be admissible in case of such assignment.
- x) The engagement will not bestow any claim of right with the incumbent for regular appointment to the post.

Fee payable SR & JR:

Rs.1000/-for general/OBC/EWS candidates & Rs. 500/- for SC/ST candidates payable in form of Demand Draft (non refundable) in favour of Commissioner MCD. The PwD candidates are exempted.

Require documents in original & Attested photocopy for SR:

1. Copies of Date of Birth proof.
2. Copies of mark sheets of professional examination
3. Copies of internship completion certificate
4. Copies of MBBS degree+ PG Degree/DNB/Diploma for SR
5. Copies of valid DMC registration
6. Copies of experience certificate if any
7. Copies of SC/ST/OBC certificate if claimed. OBC certificate will be considered only if issued from Govt. of India.
8. One Passport size photograph

Incomplete application will not be considered. 4% post are reserved for PwD as per the guidelines of Govt. of India.

Chairman reserves the right to consider or reject any of the application.

If suitable candidates are not available against any particular reserved seat, engagement for maximum of forty four days contract or till post filled by regular candidates.


