3. Age relaxation for SC/ST/OBC- NCL /Ex-servicemen/PWD will be given as per rules.
4. Candidates seeking reservation/age relaxation benefits under SC/ST/OBC-NCL/PWD category must ensure that they are entitled to such reservation as per eligibility prescribed in the notice and as per the instructions issued by Govt. of India. They should also be in possession of the original certificates in the prescribed format of Govt. of India in support of their claim.
5. The recruitments are purely on contractual basis and selected candidates will have no claim for regularization of the service in the hospital.
6. No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates for appearing in the interview.

10. Candidate should bring their own application Performa (Annexure A) **{attached}** and application should be submitted separately for each post.
11. Mere declaration of the selection of candidate does not confer the right to the post. This is subject to scrutiny of the documents at the time of joining.
12. The candidate should have to produce the proof of essential academic qualification on the day of interview failing which his/her candidature for the said post will not be considered.
13. The candidate should bring two recent passport size photographs along with one set of attested photocopies and original of testimonials
14. **Candidates who have completed 3 years Senior Residency from any Govt. Institute need not appear for interview for 3 year Residency Scheme.**
15. The candidate who is in service should submit "No Objection Certificate" from the employer at the time of interview.
16. The selected candidate will have to furnish a DD/Bankers Cheque for an amount of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) drawn in favor of "ESI Fund Account No. 1" payable at Noida towards security deposit.
17. In case of non-appearance of eligible candidates for SR against the advertised category, the vacancy may be filled by available qualified and eligible SR candidates for 39 days.
18. **Part time engagement of one contractual employee in two ESIC Hospitals at the same time shall not be permissible.**
19. Interested candidates may appear for the Walk in interview as per given schedule along with their original documents & Xerox copies in support of their Date of Birth, Proof of Educational Qualification, Experience Certificates, Caste Certificates.

12. EWS candidates are required to submit latest EWS Certificate as per Central Govt. Performa, not more than one year old from the date of Interview.
