I declare that I am a citizen of India and that I desire to be enrolled as a member of the Home Guards for Orissa and have no intention of permanently leaving the Limits of the Orissa state for at least three years after enrollment and that I am not under any obligation to serve in any other force.

I understand that:

1. In any emergency I shall be liable to be called out on duty at any time and for any period and in any part of the state of Orissa.
2. I shall be liable to undergo training and attend parades in accordance with the orders of my superior officers
3. I shall be required to take the following pledge, namely:-

I.....residing at .....do solemnly and sincerely declare and affirm that I will well and truly serve the Government of Orissa as a member of the Home Guards without favour or affection, malice or ill will communal or political bias and that I will, to the best of my powers, discharge the functions and duties assigned to me for the meeting and emergency, and for serving the people in any calamity and for the protection of persons, the security of property and the public safety and that I will to the best of skill and knowledge discharge all the duties as such member, faithfully according to law.

4. I shall be required to serve for a period of three years in the Home Guards unless I am allowed to resign in pursuance of the Orissa Home Guards rules, 1962

Note: (1) If you are a Government servant or an employee in a local authority a firm or any other office. you should send this form through your superior officer with his certificate that he has no objection to your attending the raining and that he will release you for duty in an emergency by any time and for any periods and in any part in the state of Orissa.

(2) After completing the form, you should post it or deliver into the Commandant, Home Guard of the District. You will receive intimation in due course whether your services can be utilized.

(3) In requesting the employer or the superior officer to issue certificate mentioned in (1) above, it may be pointed out that emergencies such as those that are referred to in paragraph (1) are not likely arise very after. Prospective Home Guards should, therefore, not be scared away nor should their employer, or superior officer, hesitate to issue the above certificate for just this reason.
