Applications are invited, in duplicate, from eligible candidates for filling up Eight (08) posts of Superintending Archaeological Engineer, General Central Service, Group 'A' (Gazetted) Non-Ministerial in Pay Level 11 in Archaeological Survey of India by deputation (including short term contract). The eligibility criteria and other details are as follows:

Officers under the Central Government or State Government or Union Territory Administration or Public Sector Undertakings or Recognised Research Institutions or Universities or Statutory or Autonomous Organisations

(A) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre, department, or (B) with five years' regular service in the grade rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in posts in level 10 in the pay matrix in the parent cadre or department, and

(B) Possessing the following educational qualifications and experience:

i) Degree in Civil Engineering from a recognised University or Institute.
ii) eight years' experience in planning, execution and supervision of civil engineering works in Government sector or any Archaeological or heritage site.

Duties: Generally assisting the Head of Engineering Branch, formulating the plans and guidelines of conservation of ancient monuments and departmental buildings, scrutinising proposals for approval of conservator proposals and new works, exercising control on the execution of the approved works and preparing reports thereon, and other related works.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ALL POSTS:-

1. The officer selected for appointment on deputation basis will be governed by the terms of deputation laid down in DoPT G.M. No. 21297-Est. Dated 29/04/1988 as amended from time to time and pay will be regulated in accordance with the DoPT G.M. No. 13921-Est. (Pay II) dated 06/01/1994 as amended from time to time, insofar as follows:

i. Period of deputation (DTC), including period of deputation (DTC) in another cadre post held immediately preceding the appointment in the same or some other Organization or Department of the Central Govt., shall ordinarily not exceed four years.

ii. The selected officers will be on deputation for a period of two years, initially which can be curtailed or extended further depending upon the requirement. The extension thereon will be given on yearly basis.

iii. The departmental officers in the higher category who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

iv. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation/short term contract shall not exceed 56 years as on the date of closing of receipt of applications.
