1. Junior Research Fellow (JRF) - (01)

Essential Qualification: M.Sc./M.Tech/ M.Sc. Tech. – Geology/Applied Geology/Allied Sciences passed with good academic record.

Job Description: Conduct extensive field surveys and data collection related to geological sites, natural resources. Analyze the feasibility and sustainability of developing geotourism at identified sites. Contribute to the preparation of reports, maps, and documentation highlighting the geotourism potential of the region. Collaborate with local communities to promote sustainable tourism practices that enhance local livelihood.

Desirable Skills: Proficiency in GIS and remote sensing tools for mapping and spatial analysis. Familiarity with project management and documentation tools. Experience in community-based tourism development or livelihood enhancement projects. Passion for environmental conservation and sustainable development and experience of working in the Himalayan terrain.

2. Office Assistant (OA) - (01)

Requirements: Good communication and interpersonal skills. Proficiency in MS Office (Excel, Word). Basic understanding of accounting principles. Experience with Tally, or other accounting software is desirable. Should have working knowledge of business English. Willingness to work in Himalayan terrain extensively is highly desirable. Emoluments: Rs. 15000/- per month consolidated.

Age Limit: Upto 30 years for JRF and Upto 35 years for Office Assistant

Age relaxation: The upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years in the case of candidates belonging to scheduled castes/tribes/ OBC, women and physically handicap candidates.

Service conditions: Appointment shall be for a period of one year initially extendable up to three years depending upon satisfactory performance. He/She shall be governed by the disciplinary regulations of the host Institute where he/she is working. Applicant needs to submit a medical fitness certificate by an MBBS doctor to carry out field work in high altitude.
