I. COMPANY PROFILE

Central Electronics Limited (CEL), situated in Sahibabad, is a Schedule B Public Sector Undertaking under the administrative control of the Department of Scientific & Industrial Research (DSIR) under the Ministry of Science & Technology was incorporated in 1974. Thereafter, CEL was conferred the status of a Mini-Ratna Category-I Central Public Sector Enterprise (CPSE) in the financial year 2024–25. CEL has emerged as a shining example of strategic revival and institutional transformation within the public sector and holds a distinctive position among public sector enterprises in the electronics industry.

The company is operating across four key business verticals: (i) Defense, (ii) Railways and next-generation electronic equipment, (iii) Integrated Solutions, and (iv) Solar Photovoltaics, with a strategic focus on developing core competencies in each of these areas. Today, CEL stands as a pioneer in the Indian electronics sector and is widely recognized for its leadership in the manufacturing of latest technology solar modules, railway signalling equipment, and defense systems. In addition to its established divisions, CEL is entering into development of a Tier-III Data Centre and a 200 MW automated solar module manufacturing line, under PPP model, further demonstrating its versatility and expanding footprint in advanced electronics and renewable energy infrastructure.

The company's commercial success is primarily driven by its strong in-house research and

development capabilities, developed in close coordination with various national laboratories, enabling it to deliver innovative and technology-driven solutions.

As a key technology platform of the Government of India, CEL plays an important role in developing and demonstrating viable technologies aimed at building national capability. It actively contributes to skill development and technological innovation, leading to the commercialisation of indigenous technologies.

The Registered Office of CEL is situated in New Delhi, while its Corporate Office and principal manufacturing facilities are situated in Sahibabad, Uttar Pradesh.

The Authorised and Paid-up Capital of the Company were Rs. 110,00,00,000 and Rs. 84,36,92,000 respectively as on 31.03.2025.

The company had a total 207 regular employees, comprising 128 Executives and 79 Non-Executives as on 31.03.2025.

II. JOB DESCRIPTION AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Chairman and Managing Director (CMD) is the Chief Executive of the Corporation and accountable to the Board of Directors and Government of India. He/ She is responsible for the efficient functioning of the Company for achieving its corporate objectives and performance parameters.

The applicant should be an Engineering Graduate/ Chartered Accountant/ Cost Accountant/ Post Graduate/ Graduate with MBA/ PGDIM from a recognized institute.

4. EXPERIENCE:

Applicant should possess adequate experience/ exposure for at least 5 years during the last 10 years in Finance/ Business Development/ Production/ Operations/ Marketing/ Project Management in a large organization of repute.

Experience in electronics Industry is desirable.

3. For candidates from SPSE/ Private Sector

- a. If a candidate conveys his/her unwillingness to join after the interview is held, he/she would be debarred for a period of two years from the date of interview, for being considered for a Board level post in any CPSE.
- b. Further, if a candidate conveys his/her unwillingness to join after the issue of offer of appointment, he/she would be debarred for a period of two years from the date of offer of appointment for being considered for a Board level post in any CPSE.
- 4. In the above cases, no request for relaxation or otherwise would be entertained.
