Qualified and eligible candidates of A.P. Ed.CET-2025 are informed to participate in web counseling for the seats available in B.Ed./B.Ed. Special Education colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh (both University and Private) for the academic year 2025-26 on payment of processing fee as given below.

I) Payment of Processing Fee:

(Before Certificate Verification)

1. Rs.1200/- (for OC/BC) and Rs.600/- (for SC/ST/PH) through online by credit card/debit card/(or) net banking through the "Pay Processing Fee" link in the website <https://cets.apsche.ap.gov.in>

2. All the candidates from 1st to Last Rank can pay the processing fee from **09-09-2025** onwards using URL <https://cets.apsche.ap.gov.in>
3. Enter A.P. Ed.CET – 2025 Hall Ticket number and rank and click on pay fee online.
4. The candidate will be directed to payment gateway.
5. Select any one mode of payment i.e., credit card or debit card or net banking and enter credentials.
6. Once the payment is success click on print button and take a print out.
7. Candidate shall note that he/she shall have paid the processing fee when candidate upload scanned copies of certificates i.e., the processing fee should be paid online by the candidate before he/she upload scanned copies of certificates.

Certificates to be produced by PH/CAP/NCC/Scouts & Guides/Sports at the time of certificate Verification at Help Line Centre, Acharya Nagarjuna University, Nagarjuna Nagar:

- a) **PH:** Certificate issued by the District Medical Board. Candidates with 40% and above is ability are only eligible.
- b) **CAP:** Certificate issued by Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer (In case of Ex-Servicemen) Identity card and Service Discharge book for verification. Candidates whose parents are domicile of Andhra Pradesh are only eligible to be considered under "CAP" Category.
- c) **NCC & Sports :** To produce Original Certificates issued by competent authorities.
- d) **Scouts & Guides :** To produce Original Certificates issued by competent authorities.
- e) **Anglo-Indian:** A Certificate issued by Competent Authority of their place of Residence.

Note: Original Certificates need not be deposited in the college at the time of admission.

Eligibility to B.Ed./B.Ed. Special Education programs:

Candidates satisfying the following requirements shall be eligible to appear for APedCET-2025.

- (i) The Candidates should be Indian Nationals.
- (ii) The Candidates should satisfy Local/Non-Local status requirements as per the G.O.Ms. No.20, Higher Education (EC) Dept., Govt. of AP dated:12.05.2025
- (iii) Educational Qualifications:

- IV)** Candidate should have secured at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor's Degree i.e., B.A./B.Sc./ B.Com./B.Sc. (Home Science/BCA/BBM and /or in the Master's Degree or any other qualification equivalent thereto. However, candidates belonging to all other reserved categories should have secured 40% marks in the qualifying examination.

Note:- The Candidates with B.E./B.Tech. should have secured at least 55% marks or equivalent CGPA.

- V)** The candidates should have completed the age of 19 years on the 1st of July in the year in which notification is issued. There shall be no maximum age limit.

Appearing for methodology paper other than eligible methodology in A.P. Ed.CET-2025 and obtaining rank does not confer any right to claim admission in that methodology.
