I) Payment of Processing Fee:

1. Rs.1200/- (for OC/BC) and Rs.600/- (for SC/ST/PH) through online by credit card/debit card/(or) net banking through the "Pay Processing Fee" link in the website https://cets.apsche.ap.gov.in

- 2. All the candidates from 1st to Last Rank can pay the processing fee from **09-09-2025** onwards using URLhttps://cets.apsche.ap.gov.in
- 3. Enter A.P. Ed.CET 2025 Hall Ticket number and rank and click on pay fee online.
- 4. The candidate will be directed to payment gateway.
- 5. Select any one mode of payment i.e., credit card or debit card or net banking and enter credentials.
- 6. Once the payment is success click on print button and take a print out.
- 7. Candidate shall note that he/she shall have paid the processing fee when candidate upload scanned copies of certificates i.e., the processing fee should be paid online by the candidate before he/she upload scanned copies of certificates.

- a) **PH**: Certificate issued by the District Medical Board. Candidates with 40% and above is ability are only eligible.
- b) **CAP**: Certificate issued by Zilla Sainik Welfare Officer (In case of Ex-Servicemen) Identity card and Service Discharge book for verification. Candidates whose parentsare domicile of AndhraPradeshare onlyeligible to be considered under "CAP" Category.
- c) **NCC & Sports :** To produce Original Certificates issued by competent authorities.
- d) **Scouts & Guides :** To produce Original Certificates issued by competent authorities.
- e) **Anglo-Indian**: A Certificate issued by Competent Authority of their place of Residence.

Note: Original Certificates need not be deposited in the college at the time of admission.

Candidates satisfying the following requirements shall be eligible to appear for APEdCET-2025.

- (i) The Candidates should be Indian Nationals.
- (ii) The Candidates should satisfy Local/Non-Local status requirements as per the G.O.Ms. No.20, Higher Education (EC) Dept., Govt. of AP dated:12.05.2025
- (iii) Educational Qualifications:

Mathematics	:	Candidates with B.A. / B. Sc with Mathematics as one of the group subjects and BCA Candidates with Mathematics at Intermediate level as a group subject or B.E./B.Tech. with Mathematics & Physics at intermediate level.
Physical Sciences	:	Candidates with B.Sc., who have studied Physics and Chemistry or allied material sciences (See Annexure-I) under Part-II group subjects or BCA candidates with Physical Sciences (Physics and Chemistry) at Intermediate level as group subjects or B.E./B.Tech. with Mathematics, Physics & Chemistry at intermediate level.
Biological Sciences	:	Candidates with B.Sc./ B.Sc. (Home Science) who have studied Botany and Zoology or allied subjects (See Annexure-II) under part-II group subjects or BCA students with Biological Sciences at Intermediate level as group subjects.
Social Studies	:	All Candidates with B.A. or Candidates with B. Com. /B.B.M. /BCA with Social Sciences at Intermediate level as group subject.

IV) Candidate should have secured at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor's Degree i.e., B.A./B.Sc./ B.Com./B.Sc. (Home Science/BCA/BBM and /or in the Master's Degree or any other qualification equivalent thereto. However, candidates belonging to all other reserved categories should have secured 40% marks in the qualifying examination.

Note:- The Candidates with B.E./B.Tech. should have secured at least 55% marks or equivalent CGPA.

V) The candidates should have completed the age of 19 years on the 1st of July in the year in which notification is issued. There shall be no maximum age limit.
