Applications are invited for one post of **Project Research Scientist-I** (Non-Medical) with a fellowship (Fixed amount of Rs. 56,000 per month + HRA (20%) in a sanctioned research project (ICMR, New Delhi) entitled "Developing TRIMs and associated co-expressed genes panel in Tumor educated monocytes (TEMo) of breast cancer patients for monitoring progression and response to therapies". The post is purely temporary and co-terminus with the project. The duration of the project will be maximum for 3 Years.

**Essential Qualification:** The candidate should have a first-class post-graduate degree in Biochemistry/ Biotechnology/ Molecular & Human Genetics/Zoology/Animal Science/Life Sciences with two years of experience and must have qualified NET/GATE or equivalent examination.

**Desirable Qualifications:** Candidates with hands-on experience in isolating and handling PBMCs, maintenance and differentiation of macrophage cultures, and expertise in fundamental techniques of cancer biology, cell culture, molecular biology techniques, and functional assays relevant to tumor immunology will be given preference.
