The Diplomat of National Board (DNB) in broad specialty and super speciality qualifications when granted in a medical institution with attached hospital or in a hospital with the strength of **five hundred** or more beds, by the National Board of Examinations, shall be equivalent in all respects to the corresponding broad specialty (MD/MS) and super speciality (DM/ MCh) postgraduate qualification, but in all other cases, Senior Residency in a medical college for an additional period of one year shall be required for such qualification to be equivalent for the purpose of teaching.

- 2. The applicants applying in response to this advertisement should satisfy themselves regarding their eligibility for the aforesaid post and must fulfill all the eligibility criteria on or before 21<sup>st</sup> December 2025 till 5:00 P.M. failing which their application will be rejected.
- 3. Candidates who wish to apply for more than one post should apply separately for each post and pay the application fee for each post and submit application forms separately for each post.
