N.B.-Compensatory time @ 20 minutes per hour of examination will be allowed for the PwD candidates.

The PwD candidates only who were allowed by the Commission to avail scribe facility in the Preliminary Examination may apply to take permission of the commission to use his/her own Scribe in the Main Written Examination and Mathematics Test. PwD candidates will not be allowed to use scribe in the Computer Skill Test.
