The position is initially available for one year and will be extended to a second year based on the candidates performance. Upon successful completion of two years, the JRF will be converted to an SRF in the 3rd year, with a salary of Rs. 42,000 + 10% HRA per month.

ME/M.Tech/MS or equivalent degree in Metallurgical, Mechanical, Materials Engineering (GATE qualification is not mandatory).

Or

BE/B.Tech/BS or equivalent 4-year degree in Metallurgical, Mechanical, Materials Engineering with GATE score. Degree from IITs, CFTIs, Institutes whose current overall NIRF ≤ 25, with at least 8.0 CGPA GATE qualification not mandatory.

Job description: The project involves carrying out exciting, innovative, cutting-edge research on advanced thermomechanical treatments, resistance spot welding (RSW), and friction stir welding (FSW) of low-carbon micro-alloyed dual-phase steel. Characterization such as XRD, XRD texture goniometer, FESEM, EBSD, TEM, APT, etc. Mechanical property determination via tensile, fatigue, fracture toughness, FCGR, impact toughness, etc. The candidate is expected to join PhD in the project mode.
